 - d. Detail of previous five years work (Experience details).
 - e. Detail of equipments, machinery & labour held.
 - f. Certificate on stamp paper that the firm/ company has not been blacklisted.
 - g. Certificate of good reputation from previous institution.
 - h. Certificate that there is no case of litigation firm/ company.
 - i. Bank guarantee of the firm/ company.
4. The proposals, prepared in accordance with the instructions in the pre-qualification documents, must reach by **1200 hrs** on or before **20 September 2017 (Wednesday)**. Applications received after 1200 hrs on 20 September 2017 will not be accepted. Proposals will be opened in presence of representative of the firm on **20 September 2017 at 1230 hrs**.
