QUALIFICATION, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMIT FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

4. On the closing date for receipt of applications as fixed in the relevant advertisement, a candidate for initial appointment to a post must possess the educational qualifications and experience and must be within the age, limit as mentioned against the post concerned in the Schedule to this notification:

Provided that the maximum age limit shall be relaxed in respect of the candidates specified, and to the extent indicated in the Initial Appointment of Civil Posts (Relaxation of Upper Age Limit) Rules, 1993, as amended from time to time.

QUALIFICATIONS/CONDITIONS FOR APPOINTMENT BY TRANSFER/DEPUTATION

5. (1) Appointment by transfer shall be made in accordance with the provisions of rule 7 and 9 of Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules. 1973.

(2) Appointment by deputation shall be made in accordance with the standard terms and conditions of deputation as prescribed by the Federal Government from time to time.

PROBATION

6. Persons appointed by promotion or initial appointment or transfer shall be on probation in accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of Civil Servants Act, 1973, read with Rule 21 of the Civil Servants (Appointment, Promotion and Transfer) Rules, 1973.
