1. **ENFORCEMENT & OPERATIONS**

(DRUG SUPPLY REDUCTION ACTIVITIES)

a. **Narcotics Seizures**

Anti Narcotics Force is functioning countrywide through its 5x Regional Directorates and 29x Police Stations. During quarter under review, **345 cases were registered** in various Police Stations of Anti Narcotics Force, while **376 accused persons were arrested** during span under review. Details of seized drugs and chemical precursors are revealed below:

12 held for selling drugs to students

RAWALPINDI: The Anti-Narcotics Force (ANF) has launched a countrywide special drive for apprehension of drug peddlers involved in supply of drugs to students in educational institutions.

According to the ANF, 12 drug suppliers were arrested and over four kilograms of drugs were seized — comprising 4.15kg hashish, 270g heroin, 80g opium, 25g ket and 80g Ecstasy powder — worth over Rs6 million in the international market, during eight search operations across the country.
