DRUG FREE SOCIETY



General

Year 2014 has been watershed in the history of ANF. During this year, ANF has achieved unprecedented successes on all accounts i.e. quantity of seizures, arrest of drug peddlers, record conviction rate as well as freezing & forfeiture of assets worth millions of rupees.

Fresh Initiatives – 2014

ANF undertook multifaceted initiatives to improve the performance of the Force. Achievements during the year 2014 are recognition of the fact that various steps initiated have started paying the dividends. Salient initiatives undertaken during the year are:-

- a. Establishment of three additional Police Stations at Naukundi, RD Qta and Peshawar (Total Police Stations increased from 25 to 28).
- b. Scope of Port Control Unit (PCU) at Karachi has been expanded.
- c. Use of CCTV cameras for effective profiling of passengers at all airports.
- d. Checking of international arrivals at all airports and checking of domestic flights from Quetta and Peshawar airports.
- e. Frequent engagement with courier and parcel companies and plan for extension of NADRA Biometric Verification System to these companies.
- f. Intelligence network of ANF has been expanded inside main cities to locate and hunt drug smugglers/ peddlers.
- g. Areas around educational institutions are being monitored on regular basis to stop/ counter sale of drugs to students.
- h. Random/ surprise checking by ANF Special Squads at all Railway Stations.
- I. Employment of ANF Avn Fleet Helicopter (MI-17) in counter narcotics operations.
- j. Extension of NADRA Verisys to RDs for speedy investigations
- K. Establishment of Canine Breeding & Training Unit (CB&TU).
 - l. Development of Software – Drug Information and Precursor Monitoring Systems.
- m. Conduct of precursors training for all users for effective precursor control/ checking.
- n. Highlighting enforcement activities on Social Media as part of awareness campaign and deterrence measure.

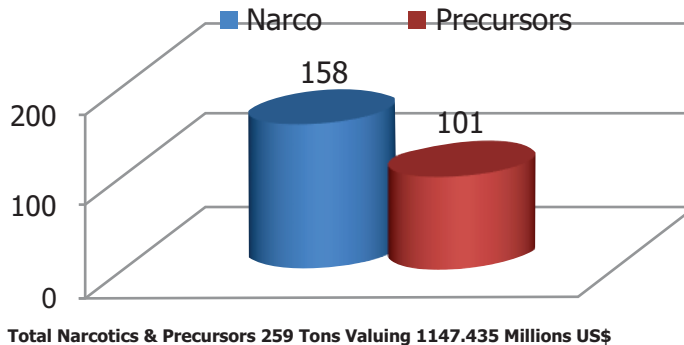

- p. Establishment of Research and Analysis Cell (RAC) at Anti Narcotics Force Academy (ANFA) Islamabad

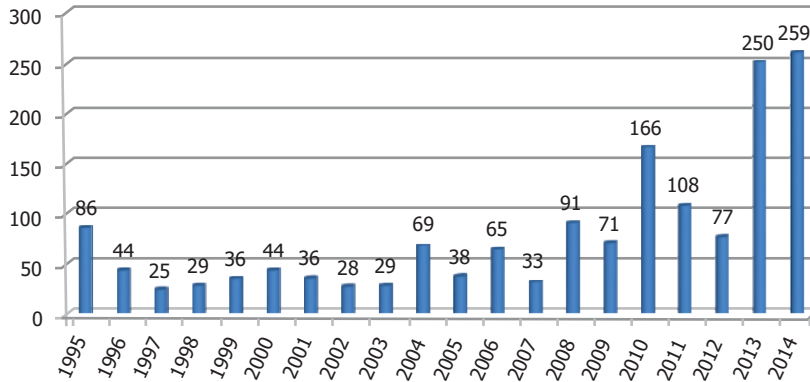
Achievements

Seizures

In year 2014, ANF seized **39130 Kgs Opium, 812 Kgs Morphine, 5497 Kgs Heroin, 106198 Kgs Hashish, 6.957 Kgs Cocaine, 5976 Kgs Poppy Straw, 135 Kgs Cannabis, 38200 Kgs Acetic Anhydride (AA), 12000 Kgs Hydrochloric Acid (HCL), 50400 Kgs Sulphuric Acid and 1.096 Kgs Ecstasy Tablets, 18 Kgs Amphetamine, 35 Kgs Methamphetamine, 3 Kgs Nitrazepam Tablets**. Moreover, the operations of the year also resulted in registration of 882 **cases** and arrest of **1091 individuals**. Total **259 tons** of different types of narcotics including psychotropic substances & synthetic drugs and precursors valuing **US\$ 1147.435 Millions** in International Market have been seized. 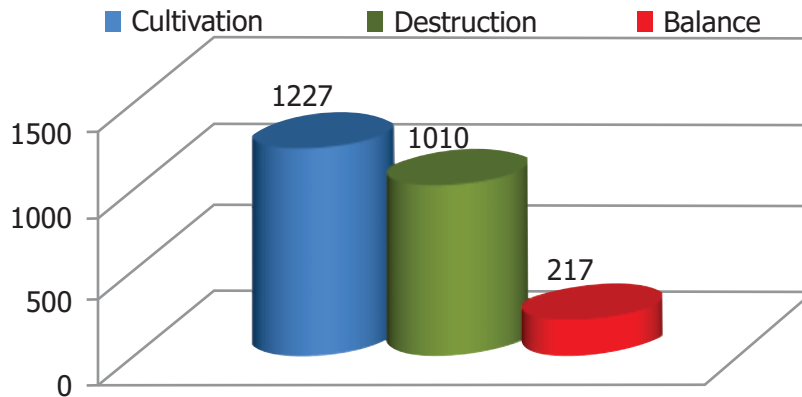


Seizures Comparison from 1995 to 2014 (in Tons)



Poppy Cultivation/ Destruction

ANF relentless efforts also remained focused to keep-off the stigma of poppy growth in Pakistan. The noble standing of Pakistan as “Poppy Free State” is being maintained since 2011. In year 2014 ANF alongwith other LEAs destroyed 1010 Hectares of poppy, graphical view is as under:-



Note:- Internationally any country having 1000 Hectares or less of poppy crop is considered as poppy free county as poppy free country (1 Acre=2.471 Hectares)

Precursors Control Efforts

The Force is following an established precursor chemicals control mechanism while rendering its all out cooperation with the INCB. Details are as under:-

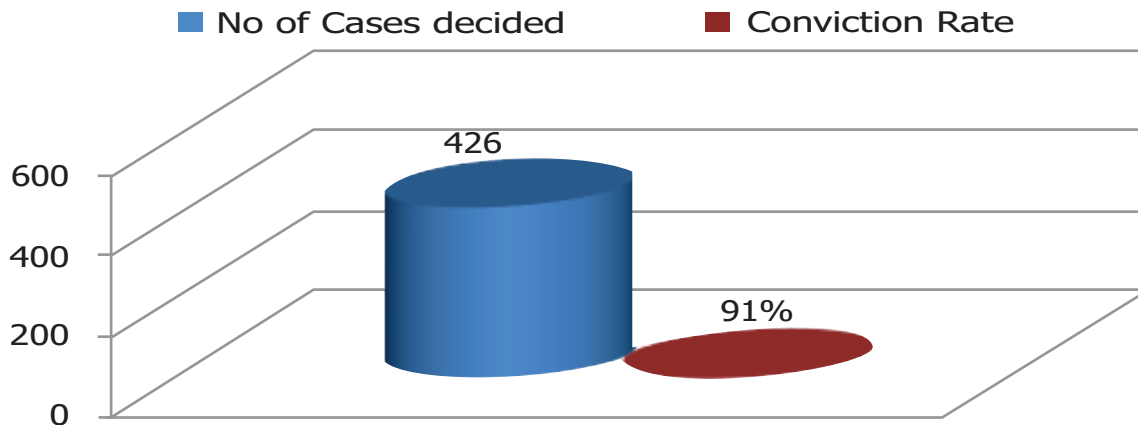
Drug Burning

The settled cases drugs were destroyed during “Drug Burning Ceremony”, 137 Tons different types of drugs valuing Rs. 8002.45 Million were destroyed on 26th of June 2014 at Islamabad, Lahore, Karachi and Quetta to mark the day and express our resolve against the menace of drugs.



Prosecution

Year 2014 also remained at peak in prosecution, whereby 426 cases were decided and successful conviction rate remained 91%, graphical view is as under:-



Assets Investigation

In year 2014, the value of frozen assets was Rs. 127.4 Million, whereas the value of forfeited assets was Rs. 11.4 Million.

International Cooperation

At international level, in line with its mandate ANF remained committed to all International Drug Organizations/ Forums, Exchange of Information and conducted 18x Intelligence Led Coordinated Operations, recovered 2099.367 Kgs Heroin and 1x International Controlled Delivery Operations & recovered 6 Kgs Heroin. In year 2014, ANF provided assistance to 26x International Drug Related Counterparts for timely completion of 197x inquiries.

Drug Demand Reduction (DDR)

ANF despite not having the budget for DDR remained forthcoming in joining hands with society in fighting the Drug Menace together. This year, 190x Mass Awareness Programs against Drug Abuse were organized. The events included Lectures, Seminars, Debates, Walks, Sports Events and Tableaus etc. In year 2014, ANF treated 1664x addicts/ patients at its Model Addiction Treatment and Rehabilitation Centers (MATReCs) at Islamabad, Quetta, Karachi and Adyala Jail, Rawalpindi.

Training

The year also remained landmark in development and honing of expertise of staff, whereby ANF Academy successfully conducted operational training of 736x individuals including 38x foreigners (Afghans), 512x ANF officials and 186x others LEAs. In 42x Training Schedules, 1x Capacity Building, 3x Basic Training, 11x Progression courses, 27x Specialized/ Sponsored courses were organized.



It is pertinent to mention that ANF is striving at its best despite its meager strength, lack of technical capacity and budgetary constraints. Its presence can be felt at 28x Police Stations, 13x International Airports, 17x Dry Ports, 3x Seaports and 6x Border Entry/ Exit points.

Notwithstanding the historic glorious performance in Year 2014, ANF look forward to address the impending challenges which supposedly are multiplied in view of increased cultivation of Poppy Crops in Afghanistan. ANF remains committed to make Pakistan and the Globe a Drug Free Society.
