



UN GENERAL ASSEMBLY SPECIAL SESSION ON "WORLD DRUG PROBLEM"

UN General Assembly Special Session on "World Drug Problem" was held from 19 to 21 April 2016 at New York, USA. The Session was attended by several Heads of State, over 50 Ministers and other Governments representatives from different countries. Pakistani delegation was led by Minister for Interior & Narcotics Control Chaudhry Nisar Ali Khan, along with a seven member delegation including Secretary NCD Mr Aijaz Ali Khan, DG ANF Major General Nasir Dilawar Shah, Brigadier Basharat Ahmed Malik and Col Zaheer Ahmed.

Speaking in the Special Session of the UN General Assembly on the world drug problem, Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control, Chaudhry Nisar Ali Khan apprised that Pakistan has put in place a robust and comprehensive legal policy and administrative framework to counter the scourge of illicit drugs. He urged the international community to 'do more' to counter the menace of narcotics in all its forms and told that this was possible through 'better coordination and cooperation' between the member countries.

Interior Minister told the world body, "We take pride in saving the world from over 1.86 Billion narcotics doses in the last three years". He said, "Last year we seized over 342 tons of illicit drugs", and added that being the top contributors in international seizures beyond its territorial borders, Pakistan contributed to almost 25 tons of illicit drugs seizures around the world. "Drug Demand Reduction, treatment and rehabilitation are high on our priority", he said. The Minister told that because of Pakistan's geographical location the country is confronted with multifaceted challenges exposing it to being the prime victim and transit country for a major portion of global opiates and cannabis. Arguing that no two countries and no two regions have a similar environment, the Minister said, "We believe that Drug Dynamics in producing countries, transit countries and target countries are diverse. Therefore there are no 'one size fit all' solutions".

Chaudhry Nisar Ali Khan expressed concern over the emerging trends in some parts of the world to legalize the use of illicit drugs saying that this would give a fillip to drug demand thus igniting the supply chain, which will have a direct fallout on our region. Furthermore, he said, the concepts lacking consensus, like harm reduction and the so-called human rights based approach are likely to further complicate the issue. He affirmed that, "We have all been endeavoring to build a drug free society, not a drug tolerant society".

The Minister said that Pakistan expects greater focus on the prime target and transit countries in terms of mustering resources for the capacity building of the frontline states in the war against narcotic drugs, commensurate to the threat they are confronted with and proportionate to their core contributions to the cause. He urged that the existing UN Drug Control Conventions should be treated as a repository of core guiding principles for developing an international counter drug approach.

He concluded by saying that what the world community decides to adopt in the coming days will help to determine the future of global efforts to save our succeeding generations from the scourge of narcotic drugs.

UN General Assembly Special Session on "World Drug Problem" at New York – 19-21 Apr

INTERNATIONAL DRUG ENFORCEMENT CONFERENCE (IDEC) AT PERU

International Drug Enforcement Conference was held at Lima, Peru. DG ANF Major General Nasir Dilawar Shah not only headed the Pakistani Delegation, but also led 24 members South and Central Asia Region Working Group. The conference was attended by representatives of 140 countries. DG ANF expressed gratitude to the Government of Peru for hosting this meeting and also acknowledged the commitment of US Drug Enforcement Administration for organizing the mega event.

DG ANF expressed that illicit drugs are one of the biggest threats to human lives, health, properties, peace and stability. Estimates reveal that more than 500 deaths per day are caused by illicit drugs overdose. Moreover, around 246 Million drug addicts worldwide and their families suffer from the miseries caused by illicit drugs. Statistics clearly show that damage caused by drugs to humanity in terms of lives, health, properties, peace and stability is much higher, more permanent and universal in nature.

While addressing the occasion, DG ANF said that international cooperation is the pivotal element in regional / global concerted efforts. World must continue such enduring efforts to enrich teamwork among drug law enforcement agencies regionally and internationally through sharing of best practices, robust information sharing, staff training and enhancing cooperation / coordination involved in drug production and trafficking. No two countries and no two regions have similar environment. Therefore there are no "one size fit all" solutions. Diversity in regional environment calls for regional and sub-regional approaches in accordance with the prevailing regional dictates and in conformity with the United Nations Conventions.

The IDEC forum is organized annually, under the management of Drug Enforcement Administration of USA, which provides a platform for sharing of problems having regional and international dimensions. Fact remains, drugs inferno is engulfing the whole world irrespective of creed, cast, nationality, religion and social standing, hence require much more to be done than ever before.





ANF ANTI DRUG DRIVE AGAINST DRUG PEDDLERS

In April 2016, ANF launched a special Anti Drug Drive, focusing on educational institutions at Islamabad and all provincial capitals of the country. In this connection 136 operations were conducted, which resulted in arrest of 155 drug suppliers and seizure of 19 vehicles. During the operations 1.344 tons of narcotics was recovered, including 44.726 Kg Heroin, 1274.775 Kg Hashish, 23.150 Kg Opium and 1.120 Kg Cocaine. The price of seized drugs amounts to Rs 1171.80 Million in International market. Majority of the operations were undertaken at Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Jhelum, Lahore, Attock, Haripur, Peshawar, Kohat, Multan, Gilgit, Sukkur, Karachi, Quetta and Qilla Abdullah.

The Anti Drug Drive mostly remained ANF venture, which emphasized the need for forthcoming response by educational institutions and other LEAs.
