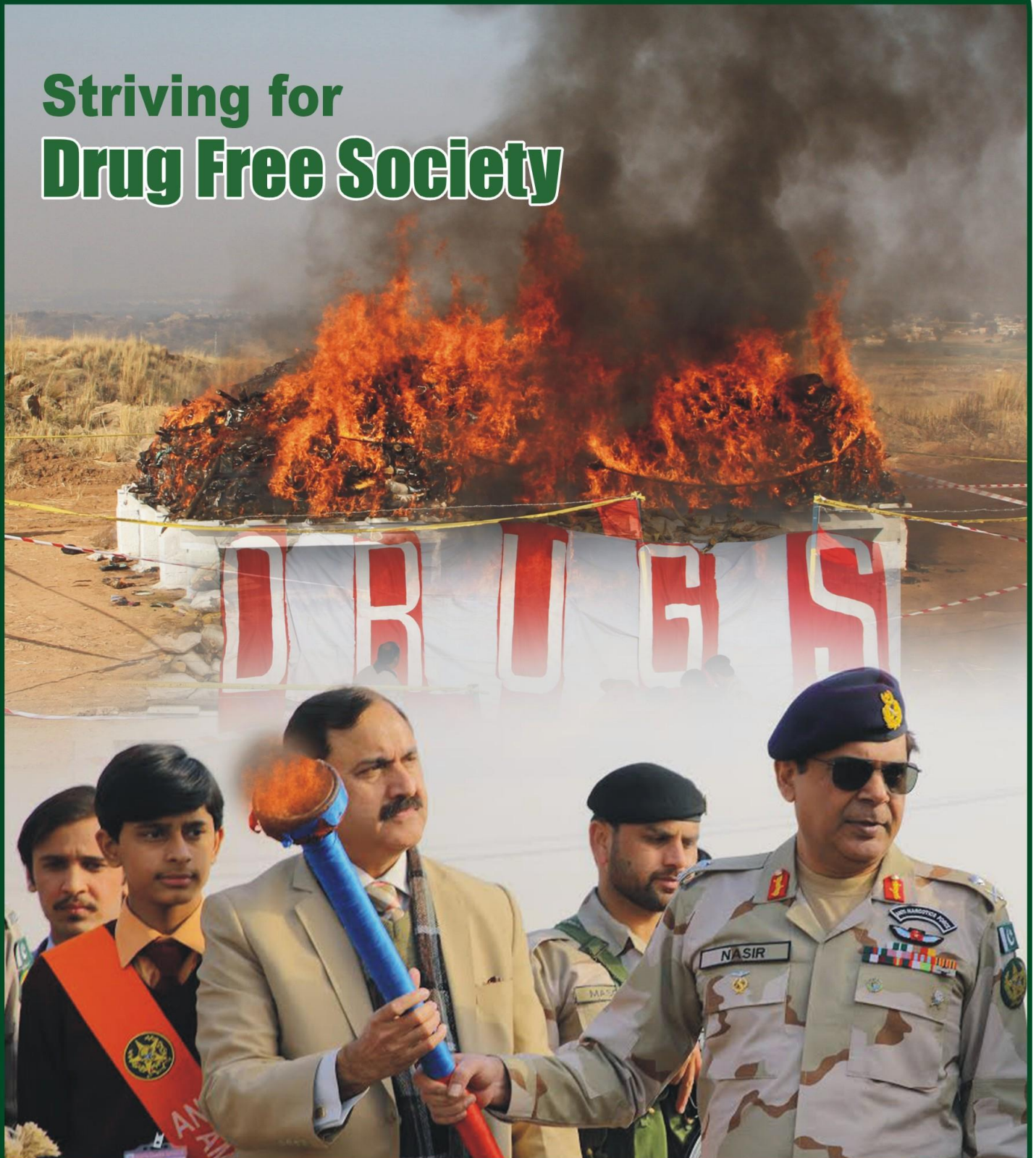

ANF Delegation – Visit to China

Substantial cooperation between the National Narcotics Control Commission (NNCC) / Ministry of Public Security (MPS) / Narcotics Pakistan commenced in early 2000 and is being strengthened with each passing year. An agency to agency Level Letter of Intent (LoI), bilateral visits of ANF Pakistan and NCB China are held on annual / biennial basis.

A two members ANF delegation led by DG ANF Maj Gen Nasir Dilawar Shah HI (M) visited China from 5 – 9 Dec on invitation from Ministry of Public Security, China to discuss the drug trafficking challenges confronting the two countries and to enhance mutual cooperation for effectively combating the drug menace in the region.

Productive meetings were held with Chinese counterparts at different levels. DG ANF highlighted Pakistan's strong resolve against drug trafficking, domestic and regional drug environment, challenges being confronted, counter narcotics strategy and achievements of the Force as well as of IATF Agencies. Both sides expressed satisfaction on the exiting levels of cooperation and showed resolve to take this cooperation to new heights by adopting a bilateral coordination in anti-drug strategy.

The fast changing environment in the Region and emerging challenges with regard to drug trafficking were also deliberated upon. Chinese authorities showed great interest to enhance and improve the capacity of ANF through training and technical assistance.

Apart from productive discussions on narcotics issue, the delegation was also taken to MPS Narcotics Laboratory, Local Drug Treatment Facility and Local Drug Control Awareness Enhancement venue.

He added that Colombo Plan will collaborate with Pakistan in respect of DDR Activities.

CASE STUDY

PATIENT AT MATRC (Karachi)

Muneer Ahmed, 20 is under treatment at MATRC Karachi. He hails from Mardan KPK and is settled at Banaras Karachi. He is a rickshaw driver by profession. He lives in a joint family comprising his parents and six siblings. His father works as a supplier of shoes and soap to mid-level shops; however, he never paid attention towards education of his children.

During childhood, Muneer remained unattended by family and spent most of his time at playgrounds and streets. He indulged in addiction due to peer pressure. Once his parents came to know about his addiction, and sent him to “Madrassa”. However, it was too late for an elderly street-boy to adjust within norms of Madrassa. Resultantly, he adopted a repulsive attitude and started cheating his parents & teachers which subjected him to severe physical punishments. He got dismayed, demoralized and rebellious. Seeing his attitude, Muneer’s parents sent him to native village, where he stayed for 6 years.

Due to prolonged absence of parental supervision at village, he became heroin addict. Therefore, he was brought back to Karachi and where he was put to work as rickshaw driver. Out of his daily earnings, he managed an expense of Rs 200 to 300 daily to satisfy his addiction. Being linked with road-traveling, he intimately knew places to buy drugs.

Muneer and his younger brother used to share the same room at their house which made his younger brother falling prey to addiction too. Sooner, his family came to know about addiction of his younger brother. Whole family got disturbed and frustrated; however, the younger brother succeeded to get out of drugs and was admitted at MATRC Karachi. Getting fully recovered, the younger brother separated himself from his elder brother which left everlasting imprints on Muneer’s personality. Resultantly, he decided to renounce addiction.

Presently, Muneer is recovering at MATRC Karachi and is committed to avoid the company of drugs users at his vicinity and work place. He got inspiration from his brother and is much to see a happy family. While recalling the days of addiction, he considers repulsion and rejection of family members and society as a major source of his frustration.

Being a healthy member of society, let’s not curtail the right of a drug-patient towards us.

ANF – CENTRAL DRUG BURNING CEREMONY 2016
DESTROYED 350.021 TONS OF DRUGS WORTH RS 2886.893 MILLION IN YEAR 2016

ANF organized Drug Burning Ceremony - 2016 at Islamabad. State Minister for Interior & Narcotics Control Mian Baligh ur Rehman graced the occasion as Chief Guest. Secretary NCD Mr Aijaz Ali Khan and DG ANF Major General Nasir Dilawar Shah HI (M) welcomed the honorable guests. Prominent guest included Foreign Dignitaries, UNODC Country Head Cesar Guedes, Officials of LEAs, NGOs, Civil Society representatives, Sports Organizations, National Heroes, Media Persons and students from different institutions including National Defense University, NUST, Qaid-E-Azam University, Bahria University, Islamic International University, ISRA University, Capital University of Science & Technology, Punjab Group of Colleges, APS School, Beacon House School, Roots, AQ Khan School/ Colleges and Margalla Institute. Occasion was addressed by Minister for Interior & Narcotics Control, Secretary NCD and DG ANF.

While addressing the occasion Chief Guest State Minister for Interior & Narcotics Control Mian Baligh ur Rehman stated that Pakistan is facing both internal and external threats, which forced us to engage in intricate operation “Zarb-i-Azb”. Under such circumstances, drug crime is badly affecting our society; hence it’s mandatory for us to address this menace with iron hand. ANF is doing extraordinary work in dealing with drug supply and demand reduction in Pakistan.

Secretary NCD apprised that ANF despite of its limited resources is fighting proficiently against drug menace. The Force is also trying to minimize this crime by launching various awareness campaigns throughout Pakistan.

UNODC Country Head Cesar Guedes, while addressing the occasion said that World Drug Report released in June 2016 also highlights the enormity of the drug problem in the region and the resultant fall out not only on Pakistan but the world at large. Pakistan is a poppy free country since 2002 but the region produces over 90% of the world's opiates which puts Pakistan in double jeopardy of being a victim as well as a transit country.

DG ANF Major General Nasir Dilawar Shah HI (M) while addressing the occasion apprised that approximately 51.577 Metric Tons of narcotics are being burnt at Islamabad today, however this year ANF burnt a total of 350.021 Tons of drugs worth Rs 2886.893 Millions at all Provincial Capitals. DG ANF apprised that ANF is homing on to “Anti-Drug Drives” in major cities, with special focus to the educational institutions.

DG ANF told that in 2016, ANF has prosecuted 424 cases, out of which 382 were convicted, which includes 4 death penalties and 81 life imprisonments, hence making 90% successful conviction rate. This year ANF has Frozen Rs 839.7 Million of Assets, out of which Rs 19.07 Million has been Forfeited and Rs 6.95 Million Realized.

He further apprised that this year, ANF has made substantial progress towards its capacity building, whereby 547 new recruits has joined ranks & files of the force, latest body-scanners have been deployed at major airports, ANF mobility has been revamped and ANF Canine & Breeding Centre has met wishful target by providing 44 new dogs.

While addressing, DG ANF said that in 2016, ANF has undertaken 378 Demand Reduction Activities events throughout the country. Talking about drug treatment facilities, he apprised that in addition to existing 145 bedded Drug Treatment Facilities at Islamabad, Quetta and Karachi, ANF is expanding this facility to 173 more beds at Karachi, Sukkur and Peshawar. DG ANF also said that ANF is looking forward to extend requisite Drug Treatment facilities at all Central Jails at provincial capitals of country. He apprised that since 2004, ANF has provided free treatment to over 13,000 addict-patients in Hospitals and 1994 addict-prisoner at Adiala Jail, Rawalpindi.

It is pertinent to mention that ANF Baluchistan, Sindh and Punjab have already burned 247, 20 and 30 Metric Tons of Narcotics at Quetta, Karachi and Lahore on 20 Oct 2016, 31 Oct 2016 and 10 Nov 2016 respectively. In view of C-PEC, ANF Baluchistan has already upgraded its deployment at Gawadar and further augmenting its intelligence ability, technical capability, mobility and cargo–filtration capacity.

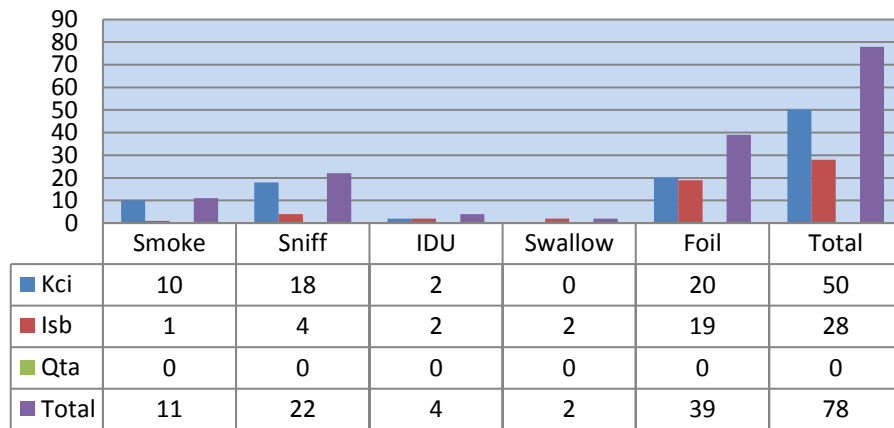
PATIENTS TREATED AT MATRCs - DEC 2016



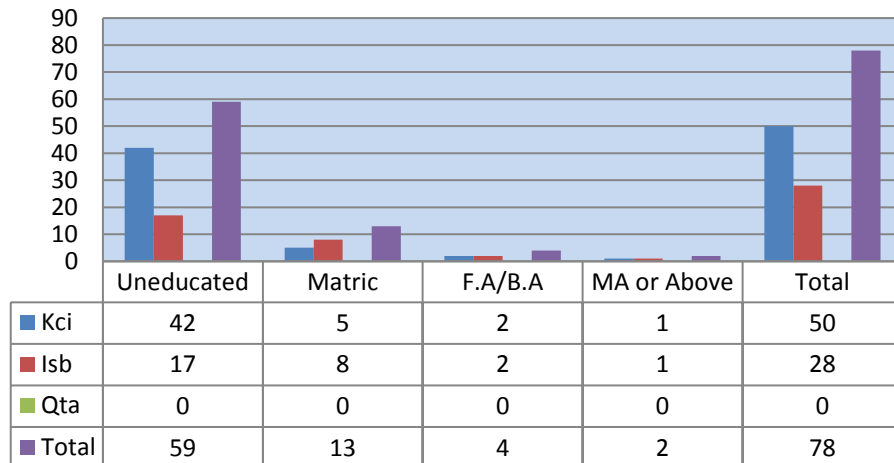
Addiction Period (Yrs)

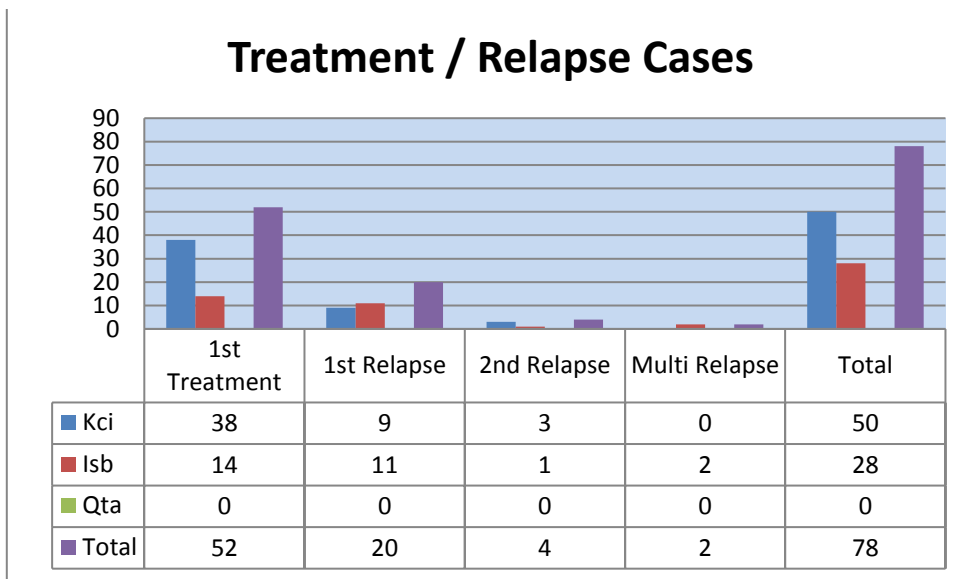
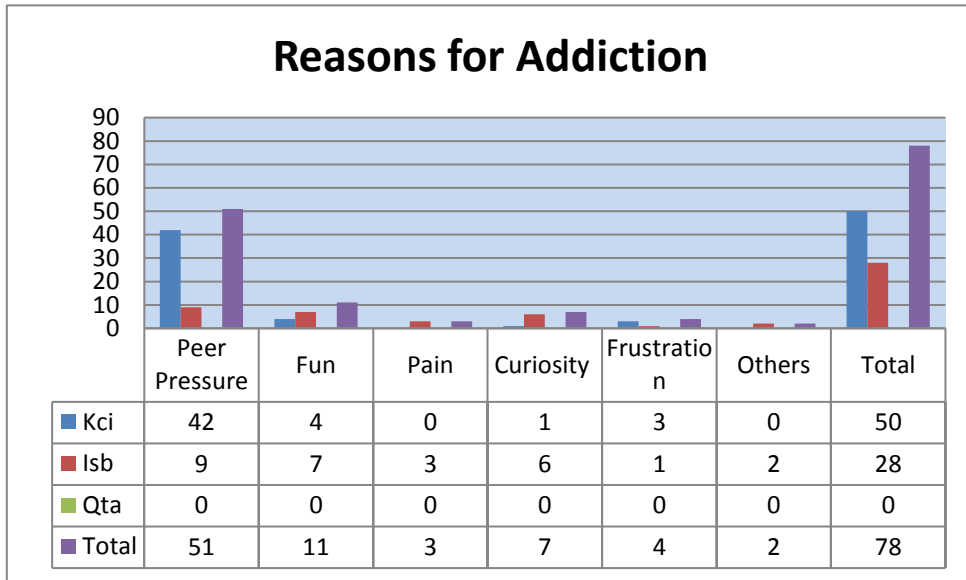


Mode of Addiction

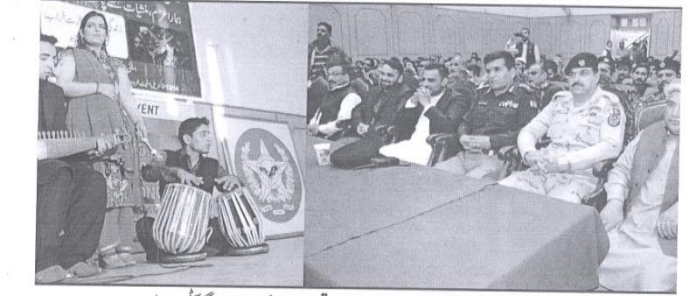
